### THE USE OF CANALS FOR THE CARRIAGE OF ALL CLASSES OF MATERIALS AND GOODS.

The principal method of transporting goods in this country is by railway. The railways have already rendered a great service to the country during the War. The demands which have been made upon them have increased, while the staff which is available for their administration is reduced. There is also a reduction in the amount of rolling stock available for ordinary traffic. There is a limit to the work which the railways can do for the Country, and, consequently, it is of the utmost importance that other methods of conveyance of heavy goods, and, indeed, of all classes of commodities, should be utilised to the utmost extent during the War. Motor traffic is not available to the same extent as it was. Certain facilities, however, do exist for transporting goods by canals and inland waterways, and this guide-book is issued for the purpose of affording information to senders and receivers of goods and materials, in order that they may have full information, to enable them to use the inland waterways of the Country to the utmost extent.

It is desirable that senders of heavy goods, manufacturers, and traders throughout the Country should render every possible assistance to the Government in dealing with the difficulties which have arisen in the transport of goods. The necessity is becoming more urgent as the War proceeds, and it will, therefore, be a patriotic step on behalf of all who can do so, if they will use the inland waterways of the Country, when they are suitable for the transport of their commodities between one point and another.

The canals in England and Wales may be divided into two categories:—

- (a) Those owned by the railway companies;
- (b) Those owned by private companies.

The former (a) were placed under the control of the Railway Executive Committee (Board of Trade) in 1914, at the time when the railways were placed under Government control.

The majority of the latter (b) were placed under the control of the Canal Control Committee (Board of Trade) on March 1st, 1917.

The total length of the important canals in England and Wales is over 2,500 miles, of which some 1,025 miles are controlled by the Railway Executive Committee, and some 1,226 miles by the Canal Control Committee, making 2,251 miles under Government control at the present time.

#### SCHEME OF CONTROL OF CANALS.

The primary object of the Canal Control Committee is to organize the traffic on the canals, so that this may be increased as much as possible, in order to relieve the congested condition of other means of transport, especially by railway.

The names of the members of the Committee and the departments and interests which they represent, are set out in Appendix 1 (A).

The necessity for local control for dealing with detail matters was realised, and three Sub-Committees in England and one in Ireland were appointed for the Northern, Midland, and Southern districts of England, and for the Irish canals, with offices at Leeds, Birmingham, London, and Dublin respectively. The names of the members of these Sub-Committees and the bodies they represent, &c., are given in Appendix 1 (B).

From this it will be noticed that each English Sub-Committee consists of an independent Chairman and Representatives of the War Office, Ministry of Munitions, Railway Executive Committee, the canal companies, and the canal carriers.

The canals under the control of each of the Sub-Committees and the addresses of the companies and their chief officers are set out in Appendix 3.

#### BRINGING TRADERS IN TOUCH WITH CANALS.

In order to bring to the notice of manufacturers, merchants, exporters, and importers, and all persons engaged in forwarding and receiving goods suitable for canal transport, the desirability of their using the canals for the conveyance of all kinds of traffic to the fullest extent, the Canal Control Committee have approached these interested parties through the Chambers of Commerce, the Local Authorities, and the Press, and the cordial response to this appeal has shown how fully its importance is realised throughout the country.

To enable manufacturers and traders to ascertain the communication by canal between any two points and to get into touch with the carriers in their districts, the maps enclosed with this pamphlet and the lists of the principal carriers, given in Appendices 4 and 6, will be useful.

In cases where a manufacturer may desire to purchase boats and run them himself, he will be able to obtain such information as he may require from the local Sub-Committee, with whom he should communicate.

#### LABOUR ON CANALS.

One of the greatest difficulties with which the Committee have had to contend has been the great shortage in labour at the present time, the canals having lost a large percentage of their staffs through enlistment in the Forces before the canals were

controlled, and through their leaving canal work for more remunerative employment, such as dock work and munition factories.

The Canal Control Committee have, however, taken steps to retain the services of all men who are indispensable for work on the canals. In addition, arrangements have been made for the employment of a number of men of the Transport Workers' Battalions for loading and unloading the boats, for carrying out maintenance works, such as the repair of locks, dredging, &c., which it is essential should be done, in order to keep the waterways in a navigable state, and for the removal and breaking up of ice, so as to keep the canals open in the event of severe frost. For the two first-mentioned purposes, a large number of men from these Battalions are now employed, while for dealing with the question of ice on canals an additional force is held in readiness.

The employment of these men is not intended in any way to supplant the existing labour supply, but to supplement it where necessary, and only when necessary, in order to maintain the flow of traffic. Where the necessity for men arises applications can be made by canal companies and carriers and firms, to the local Committees of the Port and Transit Executive Committee, consisting of one member of the Canal Control Committee, one representative of the War Office, and a representative of Labour. The names of the members of these local Committees are given in Appendix 1 (c). When application is made for the services of men from the Transport Workers' Battalions, the question whether the necessity has arisen for the employment of these men will be decided by the local Committee, and inability or failure on the part of civilian labour to handle the traffic effectively and promptly, alone, will justify the withdrawal of men of the Transport Workers' Battalions from their military duties.

By arrangement with the War Office, applications can be made for men over 25 years of age who have joined the Army for their transfer into the Transport Workers' Battalions, whence they are drafted back temporarily to their previous employers on the canals, although they still remain in the Army. In order to provide experienced boatmen, of which class there is a considerable shortage, men from the Transport Workers' Battalions without previous experience on the canals are now being trained on some of the Canals.

#### IMPROVEMENT OF TRAFFIC ON CANALS.

A very large traffic is carried on some of the inland waterways in this country, notably on the Birmingham Canals, the Aire and Calder Navigation, the Bridgewater Canals, and the Leeds and Liverpool Canal, and the special attention of the Committee is directed towards increasing this traffic, particularly in connection with the conveyance of Government grain and foodstuffs, coal, and munitions. Recent traffic returns show a large increase in the carriage of coal by canals in the Birmingham district. Traders and manufacturers who have hitherto dispatched their

goods by railways should now make use of the canals, for whereas formerly a quicker delivery could be obtained by railway than by canal in certain localities, this is not always the case under present circumstances, while it is generally found that a more steady and regular flow of traffic can be obtained by canal than by railway.

#### CANAL CARRIERS.

Except in a few cases, the canal companies are not carriers, their business being confined to keeping the waterways in a good navigable state of repair and to the collection of tolls, as owners of the waterway. The carriage of goods on the canals is mainly undertaken by firms of carriers owning a fleet of boats, tugs, &c., and also by numerous carriers, who own only one or two boats and a few horses, and who, generally, carry short-distance traffic only. Canal carriers are known as "Bye-Traders," as distinct from canal owning companies which also carry.

A list of the carriers on canals is given in Appendices 4 and 6.

#### RAILWAY OWNED CANALS.

By arrangement with the Railway Executive Committee, by whom the Railway-owned Canals are controlled, particulars of these canals have now been included in the Handbook, and are given in Appendices 5 and 6. These canals are inter-connected with those under the Canal Control Committee, and a considerable amount of traffic passes between them; the additional information now given should, therefore, be of assistance to traders, &c.

All matters relating to Railway-owned Canals, apart from traffic, should be addressed to the Railway Executive Committee, 35, Parliament Street, S.W.1.
